


FEBRUARY NEWSLETTER



- **Intensive Outpatient Programs:** Designed to help clients address substance use issues while allowing them to maintain their daily responsibilities.
- **Comprehensive Recovery Care:** The center provides rehabilitation services to help clients conquer drug and alcohol use and work towards full recovery.
- **Educational Components:** Patients learn about addiction, treatment goals, and the 12-Step program as part of their recovery process.
- **Referral Services:** For clients needing higher-level care, referrals to inpatient treatment are available.
